Synergy Event in Walsall

The Prevent Coordinator has organised a West Midlands Police, CTU led Synergy Event which will be held at Walsall Football Club, Poundland Bescot Stadium, Walsall on Monday 10 October 2022.

The training event is specifically aimed at professionals working in areas such as Adult Social Care, Children's Services, Mental Health Services and Youth Justice Services and certainly those agencies/organisations who have the potential to work with some of the most vulnerable people in society. Participants will be divided into groups and encouraged to work together in order to safeguard a young person who has been referred into 'Prevent'. The morning will highlight the importance of identifying threat and risk and sharing those concerns to the right people. Staff from West Midlands Counter Terrorism Unit will lead the event and help participants in understanding the signs of radicalisation as well as providing some detailed training around Extreme Right Wing ideology.



Our CTU team have organised a Youth Café Event at Walsall Football Club (Community Programme Kick Starts) on **Friday 16 September 2022**.

Youth Cafes – focus on educating young people on exploitation by looking at drug misuse, knife crime, county lines and radicalisation to extremism. The youth cafes sessions are 2 hours long and are available in schools and community centres across the region for students aged 11-16.

New Security Minister Appointed

On 7 July, **Stephen McPartland** was appointed as the new Security Minister at the Home Office with responsibilities including counter-terrorism, serious and organised crime, cybercrime, economic crime and hostile state activity.

Commissioner for Counter Extremism

On the 27 July **Robin Simcox** was appointed as the substantive Commissioner for Countering Extremism (CCE). The CCE is a non-statutory expert committee of the Home Office which operates independently that supports society to fight all forms of extremism and advises the government and external partners on new policies to deal with these threats.

This training service is for people working in sectors covered by the Prevent duty, such as education, health, local authorities, police, prisons, probation and youth justice. Other sectors that are not covered may also complete this training.
